# 1. General

## 1.1. Organizer

- 1.1.1. The 22<sup>nd</sup> FAI European Open Aerobatic Championship 2021 (EAC 2021) will take place under the auspices of the Aeroclub of Czech Republic.
- 1.1.2. The operational Organizer is Aeroclub Břeclav, Airfield Břeclav, Czech Republic.

## 1.2. Place and Date

- 1.2.1. The event will take place at Břeclav Airfield (LKBA), located about 85 km North of Vienna and 50 km South of Brno (the second largest city of the Czech Republic).
- 1.2.2. More info about airfield is available at [eac2021.cz](http://eac2021.cz).
- 1.2.3. The event will take place in the period: **August 20<sup>th</sup> to August 28<sup>th</sup>, 2021.**
- 1.2.4. Official training days will begin on **August 17<sup>th</sup>** and will end on **August 20<sup>th</sup>, 2021.**
- 1.2.5. The opening briefing will be on **August 20<sup>th</sup>, 2021**, at approximately 20.00LT.

## 1.3. Training Flights

- 1.3.1. Official training flights at LKBA airfield will be possible from **August 17<sup>th</sup> till August 20<sup>th</sup>, 2021.** The competition box will be marked during official training days.
- 1.3.2. Earlier training flights are possible with the previous agreement of the Organizer. In case of need, please contact the Organizer at e-mail: [info@eac2021.cz](mailto:info@eac2021.cz) or using the contact information in part 10 of this document.
- 1.3.3. Training at other airfields in vicinity is possible with the previous agreement of the Organizer. In case of need, please contact the Organizer at e-mail: [info@eac2021.cz](mailto:info@eac2021.cz) or the other contact information in part 10 of this document.
- 1.3.4. Booking of slots for official training days will be available at the official contest website [eac2021.cz](http://eac2021.cz) from **July 19<sup>th</sup>, 2021.**

## 1.4. Schedule

- 1.4.1. Official working hours of the Contest Office and the Organizer will be from 08.00LT to half an hour after the landing of the last competitor or 18.00LT whatever comes later.
- 1.4.2. These hours are valid for any official inquiries or information or deposit of claims/protest concerning the contest during the contest's period.
- 1.4.3. All times are stated in local time (LT=UTC+2 hrs).
- 1.4.4. The Schedule may be changed due to technical and organizational reasons as well as the weather conditions.

## 2. Regulations

### 2.1. Rules

2.1.1. The EAC 2021 will be conducted according to the following rules:

- FAI Sporting Code – General Section,
- FAI Sporting Code – Section 6 Part 1,
- Flying Rules published by the Civil Aviation Authorities of the Czech Republic,
- Local Regulations.

## **3. Participation, Competitors, and Aircrafts**

### **3.1. Participants**

- 3.1.1. All FAI member NACs may be represented at the EAC 2021 by the team and/or an individual competitor/observer.
- 3.1.2. The EAC 2021 will be held in Open format and entries of non-European countries are invited. Non-European competitors result will be included in overall results according to Section 6 Part 1.
- 3.1.3. Entries will be accepted from National Aero Clubs only (according to FAI Sporting Code, Section 6 Part 1).
- 3.1.4. Other non-NAC entries will be accepted according to FAI Sporting Code, Section 6 Part 1.
- 3.1.5. Each competitor should be a holder of:
  - a valid Pilot License with an aerobatic extension according to competitor's national legislation,
  - a valid FAI Sporting License,
  - a valid Medical Certificate.

### **3.2. Arrivals and logistics**

- 3.2.1. The organizer requires participants to announce the expected arrival date to coordinate airfield operations and aircraft storage. Organizer offers to arrange accommodation in hotels which will be used during the championship also for training days.

### **3.3. Aircraft**

- 3.3.1. All participating aircraft must satisfy the performance criteria essential for competition flights in the Unlimited aerobatic category.
- 3.3.2. For all competing aircraft, a valid Certificate of Airworthiness of the related country must be presented.
- 3.3.3. For all competing aircraft using the airspace of the Czech Republic, liability insurance must be concluded with respect to damage caused by the operation of that aircraft to third parties covering a minimum amount in SDR (Special Drawing Rights) or equivalent value of any other freely convertible currencies, for the aircraft with MTOW as mentioned below:
  - MTOW up to 1000 kg                      1.500.000 SDR (approx. 1.800.000 EUR)
  - MTOW above 1000 kg to 2700 kg      3.000.000 SDR (approx. 3.600.000 EUR)
- 3.3.4. Each competing aircraft must be insured against 3rd Party Public Liability, according to EU Regulation (EC) No. 785/2004, claims with a minimum amount as mentioned above, according to MTOW. Aircraft arriving in the Czech Republic must be able to present their insurance policy with a copy in English, certified by the Insurance Company.

- 3.3.5. All competing aircraft must be equipped with VHF radio channel separation of 8,33 kHz according to Implementing Regulation (IR) 1079/2012 of the European Commission valid from January 1<sup>st</sup>, 2018.
- 3.3.6. Hangar space for competitors' aircraft will be available free of charge for the period of the Championship.
- 3.3.7. In case of insufficient hangar capacity, priority will be determined by the Organizer. In case of doubt, the order of received Entry Fee payment dates will be taken into account.

### **3.4. Support to Participants**

- 3.4.1. Organizer will provide individual support to those Participants who wish to rent aircrafts by providing list of those available and will provide contact with their owners. Please note, that final agreement for aircraft use will always be up to the negotiation between Participant and Owner. Organizer will not act as third party in such negotiation or agreement.
- 3.4.2. Organizer will provide maximum support with legislative arrangements concerning traveling to and from Czech Republic (EU), pilot's licensing to carry out flying related to EAC 2021 and other related topics.
- 3.4.3. In case of need for such support, please contact organizer using e-mail [info@eac2021.cz](mailto:info@eac2021.cz) or the other contact information in part 10 of this document.
- 3.4.4. Support will be provided only to Participants who sent their Preliminary Entries within deadline as stated in Part 5.1 of this document.

## **4. Team Composition**

### **4.1. Competitors**

- 4.1.1. As specified in part 3.1. of this Bulletin.

### **4.2. Other Team Members**

- 4.2.1. Each team may include Team Members according to FAI Sporting Code, Section 6 Part 1.

### **4.3. Observers**

- 4.3.1. Other persons (i.e., team member's relatives) will be accepted as observers of the National Team. No Entry Fee for observers will be collected, but expenses with a stay at the airfield, meals, accommodation and attendance at Opening and Closing ceremonies or other events of championship official program need to be covered individually. This option will be available at the info center during the championship.

## 5. Entries and Registration

### 5.1. Preliminary Entries

- 5.1.1. Organizer kindly ask national teams to indicate number of competitors and other team members who are willing to participate at the EAC 2021. Number of participant should be as real as possible, but is not binding in any form.
- 5.1.2. Please send you Preliminary Entry Forms not later than **April 30<sup>th</sup>, 2021**.
- 5.1.3. Organizer will provide individual support for aircraft rental, licenses validation and other services only for those national team members who sends their preliminary entries information before given deadline.

### 5.2. Deadline for the Entries

- 5.2.1. The Official Entry Forms, as well as the Entry Fees, must be provided to the Organizer not later than **June 15<sup>th</sup>, 2021**.

### 5.3. Registration

- 5.3.1. Registration can be made using the following communication channels:
  - Ordinary mail - send your applications to the address specified in part 10.1.
  - Electronically using email – use email address [info@eac2021.cz](mailto:info@eac2021.cz) in which case registrations should be considered as valid after confirmation from the Organizer.
  - Electronically using the webform at website [eac2021.cz](http://eac2021.cz). In this case, the confirmation letter form NAC needs to be uploaded. More details available on the contest website.
- 5.3.2. **Registration is valid and complete by submitting the Official Entry Forms** or online registration form with NAC confirmation by mail, e-mail, or online **AND by accepted payment** at the bank account specified in part 10.1.

### 5.4. Free Known sequence submission

- 5.4.1. The Free Known sequence of each competitor should be submitted not later than two days before the opening briefing.
- 5.4.2. **The deadline for the Free Known submission is on August 16<sup>th</sup> (MON) at 23.59 LT.**
- 5.4.3. Competitors may submit their Free Known sequence to the e-mail address [sequence@eac2021.cz](mailto:sequence@eac2021.cz) or [info@eac2021.cz](mailto:info@eac2021.cz). Every submission will be confirmed. **Sequence submissions are not valid without confirmation.**
- 5.4.4. Each competitor must submit a computer file of his Free Known sequence in one of the acceptable formats.
  - 5.4.4.1. **PDF file** - The PDF file alone will not be accepted and it must be accompanied with seq or Visio file. The PDF file must contain complete pages for forms "A", "B", and "C" as well as forms "L" and "R".

5.4.4.2. **seq or Visio file** - The competitor is responsible that the software used has been updated to comply with the Aresti System (Condensed) and Section 6, Part 1 regulations as currently amended by CIVA.

5.4.4.3. Every file (PDF/seq/Visio) shall contain the following information (this is an example):

5.4.5. Hard copies, hand drawings, alone PDF files or OpenAero sequence link will not be accepted as correct sequence submission.

## 6. Entry Fees

### 6.1. Entry Fees

6.1.1. Entry Fees are specified as follows:

- Competitor: **EUR 1950**
- Other team members and observers: **EUR 1600**

6.1.2. To pay the Entry Fee, please use the bank details provided in paragraph 11.1.1.

6.1.3. The Entry Fee covers:

- accommodation of participants during the Championship as specified in paragraph 8.1,
- three meals per day as specified in paragraph 8.2,
- fuel and oil for competition flights,
- official and social functions,
- program arranged by the Organizer,
- the CIVA Sanction Fee - 160 EUR per pilot.

6.1.4. A single room will be charged by an additional fee of **200 EUR**.

6.1.5. Any participant wishing to query the arrival and clearance of their fees should contact the Organizer using e-mail [info@eac2021.cz](mailto:info@eac2021.cz) or the other contact information in part 10 of this document.

6.1.6. Entry Fees must be paid in full amount and bank fees must be charged to the sender's account.

### 6.2. Entry Fee Payment and Deadlines

6.2.1. Deadline for Entry Fee payment is **June 15<sup>th</sup>, 2021**.

6.2.2. If payment is made **later than June 15<sup>th</sup>, 2021**, an additional **EUR 200** will be charged.

6.2.3. If payment is made **later than July 15<sup>th</sup>, 2021**, an additional **EUR 400** will be charged.

### **6.3. Entry Fee Refund Policy**

6.3.1. If a registered competitor or official should withdraw, his/her NAC may substitute another pilot or official with no financial penalty. If a participant wishes to cancel their entry, the NAC representative must contact the Organizer. The date of withdrawal will be noted by the Organizer and will set the proportion of the fee to be refunded by the Organizer.

6.3.2. Withdrawal before June 15<sup>th</sup>, 2021 – 100% of the entry fee will be refunded.

6.3.3. Withdrawal after June 15<sup>th</sup> and up to July 15<sup>th</sup>, 2021 – 50% of the Entry Fee will be refunded.

6.3.4. Withdrawal after July 15<sup>th</sup>, 2021 – no Entry Fee will be refunded.

6.3.5. In the case of Entry Fee refunds, the refunded amount will be reduced by any bank fees that apply on the Organizer side.

6.3.6. If a competitor is disqualified from the event according to FAI Sporting Code, Section 6 Part 1, no Entry Fee will be refunded.

### **6.4. Other Fees**

6.4.1. Fees for additional accommodation (i.e. during training days, for family members and so on) is following:

- double room - 50 EUR per night / per person
- single room – 70 EUR per night / per person

6.4.2. Fee for use of the Airport during Official training days is without charge.

6.4.3. Fee for use of the Airport for other training days is 50 EUR per day / per pilot.

## **7. Protests**

7.1.1. The protest must be submitted, accompanied by the payment of 70 EUR as Protest Fee.

## **8. Accommodation and catering**

### **8.1. Accommodation**

8.1.1. The Organizer will cover accommodation for Competitors and other Team members from **August 20<sup>th</sup> to August 29<sup>th</sup>** (9 nights).

### **8.2. Catering**

8.2.1. The Organizer will arrange three meals per day and refreshment for all participants. Breakfast will be provided at the hotel. Lunch and dinner will be provided at airfield.



- 8.2.2. Meals for Competitors and Team members will be provided from **August 20<sup>th</sup>** (dinner) to **August 28<sup>th</sup>** (dinner).
- 8.2.3. Meals and refreshments will be available during official training days in the local airport restaurant.

## **9. Officials**

- 9.1.1. No Entry Fee is required for CIVA appointed Officials.
- 9.1.2. Additional Officials (i.e. additional judges and their assistants) are subject to Entry Fee conditions for Other participants as stated in part 6 of this document.
- 9.1.3. Officials are requested to contact Organizer with their traveling plans **not later than July 15<sup>th</sup>, 2021**.
- 9.1.4. Organizer covers accommodation and meals for following Officials:
- Three members of the International Jury.
  - Chief Judge and 2 Assistants.
  - 7 CIVA selected Judges.
  - 7 CIVA selected Judge Assistants.
- 9.1.5. The Organizer will cover accommodation for Officials from **August 20<sup>th</sup>** to **August 29<sup>th</sup>** (9 nights). Meals will be provided from **August 20<sup>th</sup>** (dinner) to **August 28<sup>th</sup>** (dinner).
- 9.1.6. **Accommodation of all Officials will be in double rooms arranged by the Organizer.** The Organizer will try to fulfill any requests for specific accommodation needs, but **additional costs (i.e., single room) will not be covered.**

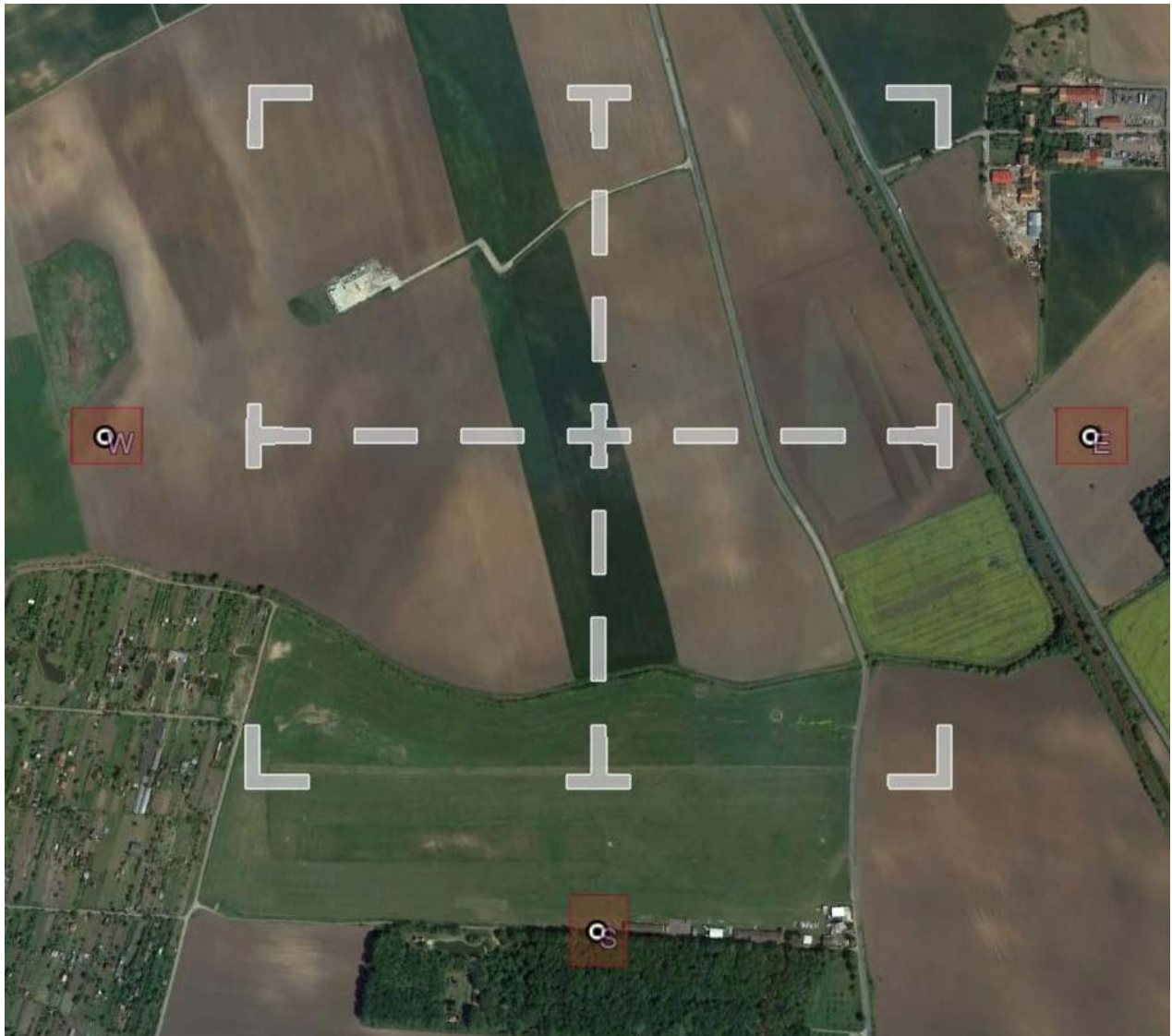
